The Court having considered the Motion of Thomas F. Lennon ("Receiver"), the Court-appointed permanent receiver for LifeClicks, LLC, 12daily Pro, and their subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, "12DP"), for Order Establishing Procedures for the Administration of Claims Against 12DP; Request to Set Claims Bar Date ("Motion") and all papers filed in support and opposition thereto; the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested; the venue being proper before this Court; it appearing that notice of the Motion was good and sufficient

1 under the circumstances and that no other or further notice need be given; and good
2 cause appearing therefor,

3 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

4 1. The Motion is granted;

5 2. All disputes regarding claims asserted against 12DP and/or the
6 12DP receivership estate shall be determined by the Court in summary proceedings;

7 3. Investor claims asserted against 12DP and/or the 12DP receivership
8 estate shall be calculated using the Money-In, Money-Out ("MIMO") formula
9 described in the Motion and the Reply to Objection to the Motion;

10 4. The deadline for submitting claims ("Claims Bar Date") against 12DP
11 and the 12DP receivership estate shall be January 31, 2008;

12 5. Investors that fail to login to the Web Portal and either (a) accept their
13 claim amount or (b) dispute their claim amount and deliver a Proof of Claim with
14 supporting documentation to the Receiver so that it is received by the Receiver no
15 later than the Claims Bar Date shall be forever barred, enjoined and estopped from
16 asserting a claim against 12DP and the 12DP receivership estate and participating
17 under any plan of distribution proposed by the Receiver;

18 6. Trade creditors, employees and other non-investor creditors that fail to
19 deliver a Proof of Claim with supporting documentation to the Receiver so that it is
20 received by the Receiver no later than the Claims Bar Date shall be forever barred,
21 enjoined and estopped from asserting a claim against 12DP and the
22 12DP receivership estate and participating under any plan of distribution proposed
23 by the Receiver;

24 7. The Claims Bar Date Notice, substantially in the form attached hereto
25 as Exhibit A, is approved. The Claims Bar Date Notice shall be served by e-mail to
26 all known investor email addresses and posted on the Receiver's website;

27 8. The Trade Creditor Notice, substantially in the form attached hereto as
28 Exhibit B, is approved. The Trade Creditor Notice shall be served by regular mail

1 on only known trade creditors, employees and other non-investor creditors of 12DP,
2 and posted on the Receiver's website;

3 9. The Receiver is authorized to hire a claims administrator should the
4 need for one arise; and

5 10. The Receiver is authorized to settle disputes regarding claims asserted
6 against 12DP and/or the 12DP receivership estate and claims asserted by the
7 Receiver on behalf of 12DP and/or the 12DP receivership estate in the exercise of
8 his business judgment.

**NOTICE TO INVESTORS OF BAR DATE
FOR ASSERTING A CLAIM AGAINST
12DAILY PRO AND PROCEDURES

PORTAL**

TO ALL INVESTORS OF 12DAILY PRO:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on December __, 2007, the Honorable Steven G. Larson entered an order in the above-captioned case setting a **deadline of January 31, 2008**, for all investors that hold a Claim against 12Daily Pro ("12DP"), to login to the investor web portal established by the Receiver ("Web Portal") and "Accept" your claim amount or "Dispute" your claim amount and submit a Proof of Claim form with supporting documentation reflecting what you believe your claim to be to Thomas F. Lennon, the court-appointed Receiver for 12DP.

For purposes of this Notice, "Claim" shall mean actual funds invested in 12DP by you and distributions from 12DP that were frozen in your account at StormPay and reversed back into the 12DP account at StormPay, less all payments of principal, interest, commissions or other amounts paid to you (including credit card chargebacks or reversals of electronic fund transfers) on account of your investment in 12DP.

To assert a Claim, you **must** log into the Web Portal and take one of the following actions **no later than January 31, 2008**:

- a. Accept your Claim Amount by checking the "Accept" box on the Web Portal for all of your reports on the "Transactions" page; or
- b. Dispute your Claim Amount by checking the "Dispute" box on the Web Portal, and deliver a Proof of Claim form with all documentation supporting your claim to the Receiver **no later than January 31, 2008**. If you are unable to view your Claim Amount, you must submit a Proof of Claim form and supporting documentation so that it is received by the Receiver **no later than January 31, 2008**.

Failure to take one of the above actions by January 31, 2008, will result in you being forever barred from asserting a claim for distribution from the receivership estate. Detailed instructions and Frequently Asked Questions ("FAQs") regarding how to access and use the Web

Portal are available at the Receiver's website (www.tlennonfor12dailypro.com) and the Web Portal itself. These instructions and FAQs should be reviewed carefully before contacting the Receiver with questions. Please note: If you do not dispute your Claim Amount listed on the Web Portal, you should not submit a proof of claim.

Submit Proof of Claim and Supporting Documentation. If you dispute your Claim Amount listed on the Web Portal or you are unable to view your Claim Amount, you must submit a Proof of Claim and supporting documentation. Failure to submit sufficient supporting documentation may result in your claim being denied. You will receive notice and an opportunity to respond if the Receiver objects to your claim. PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on December __, 2007, the Honorable Steven G. Larson entered an order in the above-captioned case setting a **deadline of January 31, 2008**, for all persons and entities (other than investors) that hold a Claim against 12daily Pro, LifeClicks, LLC, and/or their subsidiaries and affiliates ("12DP"), to submit a proof of claim to the Receiver.

For purposes of this Notice, "Claim" shall mean (a) right to payment, whether or not such right is reduced to judgment, liquidated, unliquidated, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, legal, equitable, or secured or unsecured; or (b) right to an equitable remedy for breach of performance if such breach gives rise to a right to payment, whether or not such right to an equitable remedy is reduced to judgment, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, or secured or unsecured, including, but not limited to, claims arising from unpaid wages and commission, sale of goods and services, rejection of an executory contract or lease. PLEASE NOTE: This notice and the Proof of Claim form attached hereto is to be used by trade creditors, employees, and other non-investor creditors only.
