**NOTICE OF BAR DATE FOR  
FOR ASSERTING A CLAIM AGAINST  
12DAILY PRO, LIFECLICKS, LLC, AND  
THEIR SUBSIDIARIES AND AFFILIATED  
ENTITIES**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on December 12, 2007, the Honorable Steven G. Larson entered an order in the above-captioned case setting a **deadline of January 31, 2008**, for all persons and entities (other than investors) that hold a Claim against 12daily Pro, LifeClicks, LLC, and/or their subsidiaries and affiliates ("12DP"), to submit a proof of claim to the Receiver.

For purposes of this Notice, "Claim" shall mean (a) right to payment, whether or not such right is reduced to judgment, liquidated, unliquidated, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, legal, equitable, or secured or unsecured; or (b) right to an equitable remedy for breach of performance if such breach gives rise to a right to payment, whether or not such right to an equitable remedy is reduced to judgment, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, or secured or unsecured, including, but not limited to, claims arising from unpaid wages and commission, sale of goods and services, rejection of an executory contract or lease. Accordingly, if you are a trade creditor, employee or other non-investor creditor of 12DP and believe that 12DP is indebted to you, whether that debt is primary, secondary, direct, indirect, secured, unsecured, or contingent, you must fill out the Proof of Claim form attached hereto and submit it to the Receiver **so that it is received no later than January 31, 2008**.

You must attach to your Proof of Claim all documentation that supports your claim, including, but not limited to, contracts, invoices and correspondence. Failure to submit sufficient supporting documentation may result in your claim being denied. You will receive notice and an opportunity to respond if the Receiver objects to your claim.

**PLEASE NOTE:** This notice and the Proof of Claim form attached hereto is to be used by trade creditors, employees, and other non-investor creditors only. Investors of 12DP that wish to assert a claim must visit the Receiver's website ([www.tlennonfor12dailypro.com](http://www.tlennonfor12dailypro.com)) and follow the instructions posted thereon regarding logging into the Investor Web

Portal, reviewing their account information, and accepting or disputing their claim amount. There is a separate Proof of Claim form available at the Receiver's website and the Web Portal for investors that elect to dispute their claim amount listed on the Web Portal.

You must inform the Receiver if you change your address after you submit your Proof of Claim. In addition, you must also inform the Receiver if the address to which this notice was mailed is incorrect.

All persons and entities seeking to have an allowed Claim against 12DP must complete and mail the Proof of Claim form and copies of all supporting documentation to the Receiver at:

IF YOU ARE UNCERTAIN ABOUT YOUR RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES, YOU MAY WANT TO CONSULT YOUR ATTORNEY REGARDING THIS MATTER.**
